¹⁹ But that night an angel of the Lord opened the prison gates, led the apostles out.... Acts 5:19a (TEV)

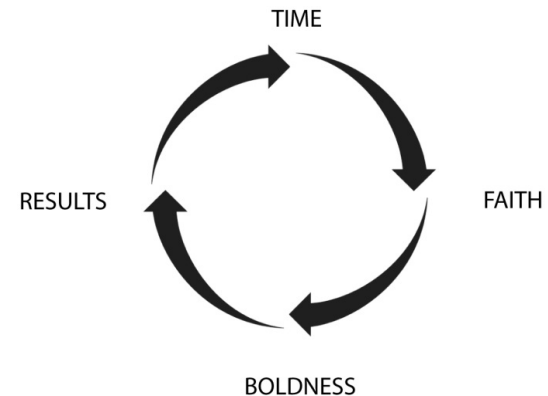
3. Always Requires _____
