

Stay Pure

Couples

Main Idea: To have a healthy marriage, couples must strive for both inward and outward purity.

- If there is one area of vulnerability that could compromise your purity, what would it be?
- What are some specific things you are doing or need to do to seek and maintain purity in your marriage?

With your Bible or YouVersion read and discuss Hebrews 5:3; 1 Corinthians 10:13; Psalm 119:9-11

- Do a reality check: Is seeking purity a priority in your marriage? Why or why not?
- What are some of the most common types of impurities you've seen try to filter into your marriage?
- What outward or inward changes do you need to make to ensure you live a life of purity?
- Describe a time when you dealt with impurity. How did you deal with it and what did you learn from your experience?

Singles

Main Idea: You can't build a foundation of sin now for a life of purity later. The best way to prepare for a pure marriage in the future is to live pure today.

- If there is one area of vulnerability that could compromise your purity, what would it be?
- What are some specific things you are doing or need to do to seek and maintain purity all throughout your life?

With your Bible or YouVersion read and discuss Hebrews 5:3; 1 Corinthians 10:13; Psalm 119:9-11

- Is seeking purity a priority in your life? Explain.
- What are some of the most common types of impurities you've seen filer into your life?
- At what point in a dating relationship do you feel physical affection can become impure?
- Describe a time when you dealt with impurity. How did you deal with it and what did you learn from your experience?
