<sup>23</sup> So all the days of Enoch were 365 years. <sup>24</sup> And Enoch walked [in habitual fellowship] with God; and he was not, for God took him [home with Him].  
**Genesis 5:23-24 (AMP)**

## Walking with God

<sup>5</sup> By faith Enoch was taken up so that he should not see death, and he was not found, because God had taken him. Now before he was taken he was commended as having pleased God. <sup>6</sup> And without faith it is impossible to please him, for whoever would draw near to God must believe that he exists and that he rewards those who seek him.  
**Hebrews 11:5-6 (ESV)**

Requires:

1. \_\_\_\_\_ in God

Enoch chose to “believe that God is” and placed his faith firmly in Him.

Enoch chose to trust God’s promises

2. \_\_\_\_\_ with God

Enoch drew near to God and faithfully walked with Him.

## Footsteps of Faith

The Results:

1. \_\_\_\_\_ of Righteousness

Enoch pleased God

By faith Enoch was taken up so that he should not see death, and he was not found, because God had taken him. Now before he was taken he was commended as having pleased God.  
**Hebrews 11:5 (ESV)**

2. A Legacy of \_\_\_\_\_

Enoch had an enduring influence on his own family.

These are the generations of Noah. Noah was a righteous man, blameless in his generation. Noah walked with God.  
**Genesis 6:9 (ESV)**

God promises a blessed legacy for those who walk faithfully with Him.

<sup>5</sup> You shall not bow down to them or serve them, for I the LORD your God am a jealous God, visiting the iniquity of the fathers on the children to the third and the fourth generation of those who hate me, <sup>6</sup> but showing steadfast love to thousands of those who love me and keep my commandments.  
**Exodus 20:5-6 (ESV)**

Know therefore that the LORD your God is God, the faithful God who keeps covenant and steadfast love with those who love him and keep his commandments, to a thousand generations, **Deuteronomy 7:9 (ESV)**

Therefore you shall keep his statutes and his commandments, which I command you today, that it may go well with you and with your children after you, and that you may prolong your days in the land that the LORD your God is giving you for all time.”  
**Deuteronomy 4:40 (ESV)**
