- Ongoing challenge Do you want to be well?

Jesus teaching all day from a boat: His pulpit is about to become an illustration.

Sea of Galilee is 680 feet below sea level. Surrounded by hills. It's common for storm to come out of nowhere.

Life with Jesus – Blind sided by a storm!

2 Things to Remember When You're In The Storm

You're in the storm with His

If God was with me, I wouldn't be going thru all this?
Having Jesus in the boat doesn't mean the storm is not going to you, it's not going to you.
He is with you – Studies show – single people live longer if something is living in the house.
How are you doing this? I'm not doing this by myself.
Never let the presence of a storm cause you to doubt the presence of God.

God is my refuge he is my strength, my ever-present help in trouble.  Psalm 46:1
Never will my God leave me – never will he forsake me. Hebrews 13:5

	Jesus was the one who said – "Let's go to the other side." Going into the storm was
	<ul> <li>They didn't experience the storm because they were out of God's will</li> <li>They experienced a storm that was in God's will.</li> </ul>
	You're saying God caused my storm – maybe – maybe not
	Can't tell you if God caused it or allowed it – but he always uses it.
	<sup>2</sup> Consider it pure joy, my brothers and sisters, whenever you face trials of many kinds, <sup>3</sup> because you know that the testing of your faith produces perseverance. <sup>4</sup> Let perseverance finish its work so that you may be mature and complete, not lacking anything. <b>James 1:2-4 (NIV2011</b>
	<ul> <li>Faith is not in the bank – but in the one who's in the boat.</li> </ul>
	Teacher – we're going to drown!
