The Challenge of the 3rd Generation

1st Gen: Marked by strong leadership, economic prosperity,

intellectual progress and/or spiritual growth.

2nd Gen: Inherits something they appreciate but didn't earn. There

is often a loss of drive, creativity, and appetite for risk.

The main goal often becomes preservation.

3rd Gen: Have only seen preservation and entrenchment. They

often lack vision, passion, and personal identity. It's common to reject the values of those who have gone

before them.

An example from the Bible:

The people of Israel served the LORD throughout the lifetime of Joshua and of the elders who outlived him—those who had personally experienced all that the LORD had done for Israel.

Joshua 24:31 (NLT)

In those days Israel had no king; all the people did whatever seemed right in their own eyes.
