<sup>17</sup> He did this in keeping with the prophecy Isaiah made so long ago:

<sup>18</sup> This is My servant, whom I have *well* chosen; this is the One I love, the One in whom I delight. I will place My Spirit upon Him: He will proclaim justice to all the world. <sup>19</sup> He will not fight or shout or talk loudly in the streets. <sup>20</sup> He will not crush a reed under His heel or blow out a smoldering candle until He has led justice and righteousness to final victory. <sup>21</sup> All the world will find its hope in His name.
